Building Service Contractors Association International Elects 2008 Board of Directors

CHICAGO – Building Service Contractors Association International (BSCAI) recently elected new members to leadership positions for the 2008 term of office to service the organization in the coming year. The 2008 executive committee includes BSCAI President, Ernest E. Clark, Jr. CBSE; President-elect, Stanley Doobin; Vice-President, J. Michael Horgan; Treasurer, Sally Schopmeyer and Past President, John Ezzo, CBSE.

Serving as BSCAI's president in 2008 is Ernest E. Clark, Jr., CBSE. Clark is President of Mister Kleen Maintenance Company, a full-service cleaning and restoration company serving Washington, DC; Maryland and Virginia since 1976. Starting with the company as a window washer, he was promoted to vice president in 1987 and ultimately to president in 1990. Under his leadership, the company has grown from approximately 40 employees in 1986 to more than 400 employees today. Clark has devoted much of his time to continuing education and enhancing the image of the janitorial industry. He has been a BSCAI member since 1986.

BSCAI president-elect is Stanley Doobin. Doobin joined Harvard Maintenance, Inc. in 1984 and became president in 1992. Since becoming president, Harvard has grown from \$10 million to more than \$160 million in revenue each year. The company services large Class-A buildings as well as Fortune 500 headquarters and professional sports arenas/stadiums. Doobin serves as president of the Accident Prevention & Safety League, Inc., the workers compensation Safety Group for building service contractors in New York, and also on the Board of Directors for New Destiny Housing Corp., a non-profit organization that provides housing and support services for survivors of domestic violence. Doobin has been a BSCAI member since 1987.

Contributing to the building service contracting industry for more than 40 years, J. Michael Horgan will serve as vice president on the BSCAI board of directors. For more than 20 years Horgan has been a member of the executive team at Hurley Corporation, a leading North American BSC, and currently holds the position of president and co-CEO where he is responsible for corporate strategic planning, major accounts and acquisitions. Horgan is also actively involved with the Building Maintenance Contractors Association of Canada as past president in 1980 and in 1981, and was a former BSCAI board member from 1997-2000. Horgan has been a BSCAI member since 1977 and recently served as the association's treasurer.

Sally Schopmeyer will serve as BSCAI's treasurer in 2008. Schopmeyer is president of Maintenance, Inc., which provides janitorial service for commercial offices, medical facilities, industrial plants, owner occupied facilities and shopping centers in Texas, Florida, Colorado, New Mexico, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Missouri and California. Schopmeyer joined Maintenance, Inc. in 1990 and has served as vice president of business development, executive vice president and currently as president. Schopmeyer has been a BSCAI member since 1990.

Serving as BSCAI's past president is John Ezzo, CBSE. Ezzo is president and CEO of New Image Building Services, Inc., a full-service commercial cleaning company servicing Detroit, Cleveland, Columbus, Toledo and Las Vegas with annual sales exceeding \$15 million. Ezzo is currently one of the youngest people to ever accomplish the highest level of industry education, the BSCAI Certified Building Service Executive (CBSE) designation.
