Building Service Contractors Association International Elects 2009 Board of Directors

CHICAGO – Building Service Contractors Association International (BSCAI) recently elected new members to leadership positions for the 2009 term of office to service the organization in the coming year. The 2009 executive committee includes BSCAI President, Stanley Doobin; President-elect, J. Michael Horgan Vice-President, Sally Schopmeyer Treasurer; Terry Woodley, CBSE and Past President, Ernest E. Clark, Jr. CBSE

Serving as BSCAI's president in 2009 is Stanley Doobin. Doobin joined Harvard Maintenance, Inc. in 1984 and became President in 1992. Since becoming president, Harvard has grown from \$10 million to more than \$210 million. The company services large Class A buildings as well as Fortune 500 headquarters and professional sports arenas/stadiums. Doobin is President of the Accident Prevention & Safety League, Inc., the workers compensation Safety Group for building service contractors in New York. Stan earned a Bachelor of Science in Commerce from Washington & Lee University in 1981 and an MBA from Emory University in 1984. He also is a Certified Public Accountant.

BSCAI President-elect is J. Michael Horgan. Horgan's contributions to the building service contracting industry span over 40 years. A graduate of Loyola College in Montreal with an Honors Degree in History, Horgan previously served as BSCAI's Vice-President and Treasurer. Michael has been actively involved with the Building Maintenance Contractors Association of Canada as Past President in 1980 and in 1981 and was a former Board Member of BSCAI from 1997-2000. He is the proud recipient of the W.I.S Hogg award for International Achievement. Since 1980, Michael has been a member of the executive team at Hurley Corporation, a leading North American BSC, and currently holds the position of President and Co-CEO where he is responsible for corporate strategic planning, major accounts and acquisitions. Horgan volunteers outside the industry as a Board Member of the Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre foundation in Toronto as well as with other medical & education foundations.

Elected Vice President is Sally Schopmeyer. Schopmeyer is President of Maintenance, Inc. located in Dallas, Texas. Maintenance, Inc. & Subsidiaries provides janitorial service for commercial offices, medical facilities, industrial plants, owner occupied facilities and shopping centers in Texas, Florida, Colorado, New Mexico, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Missouri, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Alabama. Schopmeyer started with Maintenance, Inc. in 1990. Since that time, she has served as Vice President of Business Development, Executive Vice President and has served as President since 1999.

Outside of BSCAI she currently on the Advisory Board of the Dallas Children's Theater and has served two three-year terms on the Board of Trustees. She is active in her church, local Chamber of Commerce and is secretary of her children's school board.

BSCAI's 2009 Treasurer is Terry Woodley, CBSE. Woodley is the Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, Woodley Building Maintenance (WBM), a full-service cleaning and facilities maintenance company serving clients in Missouri, Kansas, Kentucky, Indiana, Florida and Arizona and has been a full-time member of the family-owned company's management team since 1997. Woodley's primary role with WBM is the "Customer Guy" as he is responsible for attracting new customers and keeping existing customers. Since joining WBM, the company has grown from 300 employees to over 1,000 employees. Prior to joining WBM full-time, he worked in the business throughout high school and college.

Woodley graduated from the University of Missouri with a B.S. in Accounting in 1988. Immediately after finishing his degree, Woodley spent four years with Touche Ross (now known as Deloitte), one of the largest accounting services companies in the world. After that, he spent five years with a large international seminar company as its Chief Financial Officer.

Serving as BSCAI's past president is Ernie Clark, CBSE. Clark is President of Mister Kleen Maintenance Company, a full-service cleaning and restoration company serving Washington, DC; Maryland and Virginia since 1976, has been active in the family business since its inception and has worked from the entry-level up. Starting with the company as a window washer, he has been involved in all aspects of the business. Clark was promoted to Vice-President in 1987 and ultimately to President in 1990. Under his leadership, the company has grown from approximately 40 employees in 1986 to more than 400 employees today. Clark has devoted much of his time to continuing education and enhancing the image of the janitorial industry. He is a past-President of the Capitol Association of Building Service Contractors (CABSC) and is active in several local business and community groups.
